3 YEARS BACHELOR PROGRAM

Our three-year Fashion Program prepares aspiring designers by giving them a firm foundation in design techniques, as well as the professional skills needed to succeed in the fashion industry.

Students learn tailoring, embroidery, draping, flat pattern, and fashion drawing. Students may also participate in the internship program, which will give them practical experience with a range of fashion design applications, from concept to finished garment.

Centered less than one kilometer from Notre-Dame cathedral in the famous Latin quarter, the Academy draws upon Paris' cultural and artistic heritage, stretching its campus across the city's museums, exhibits, cafes, and fashion houses.

The PAA works with its international students in helping to complete the necessary paperwork for visas and residency permits.

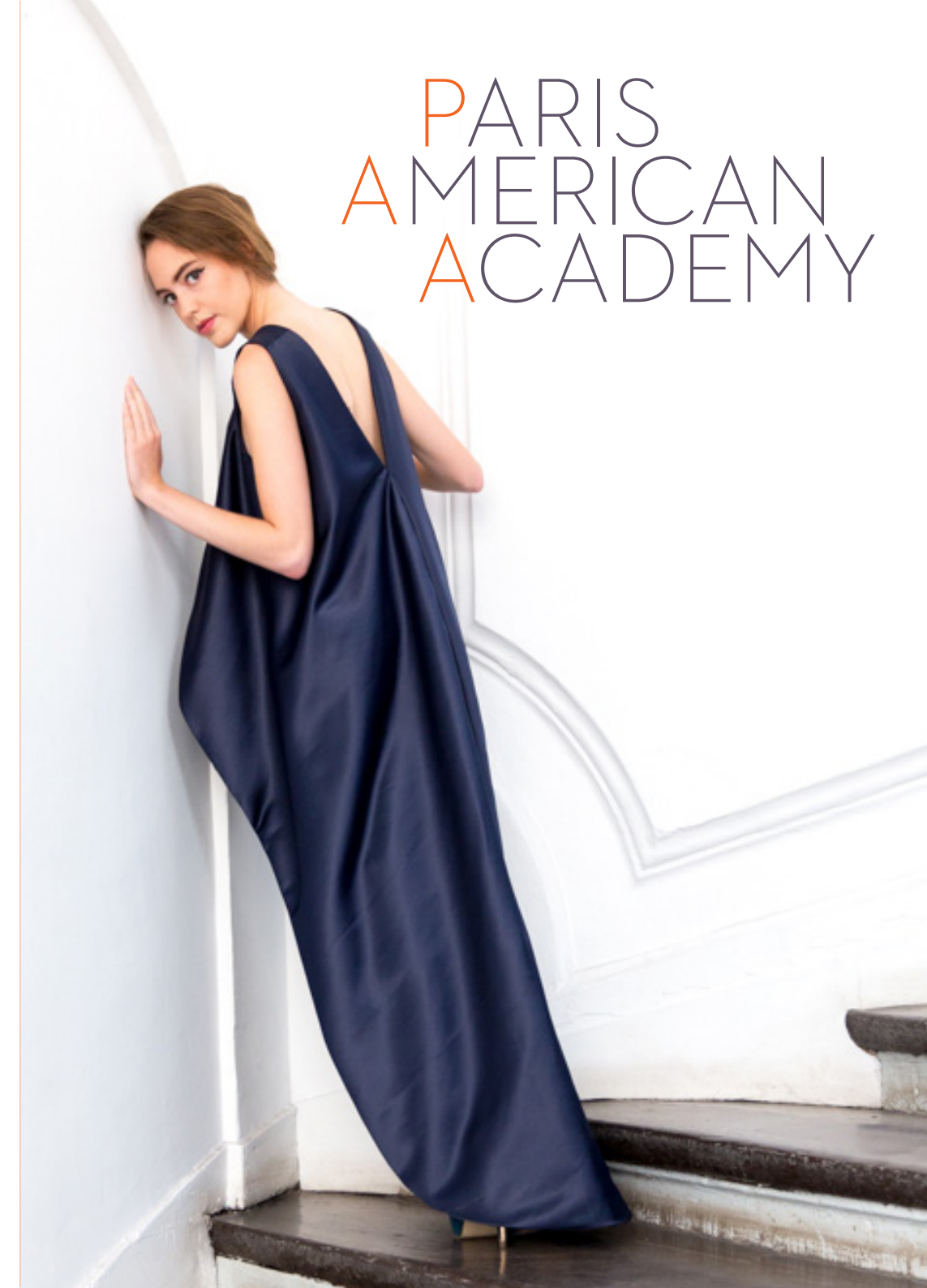
